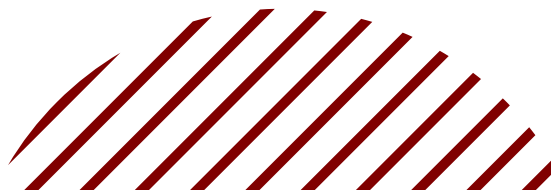

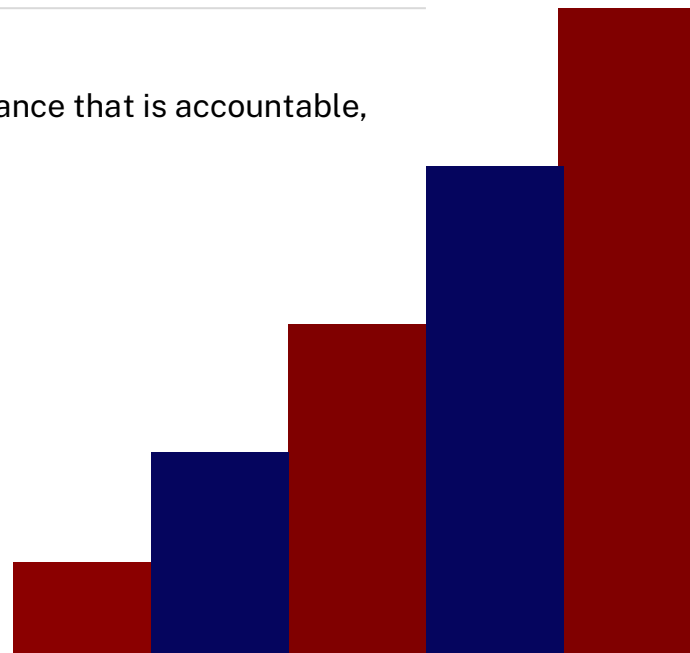
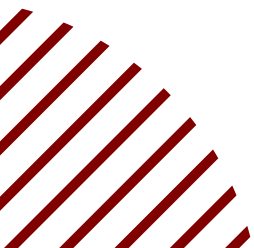

■ Business Organization Manager

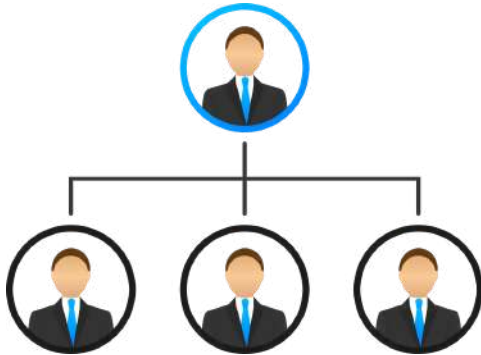

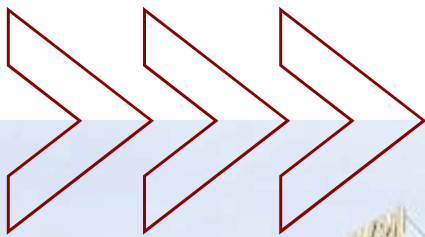

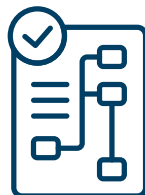

❖❖ Lecture System and Curriculum

Lectures at PDIM-UMM are designed to be conducted efficiently and effectively, not only for individuals who have flexible time availability but also for those who are engaged in professional commitments. The program requires a total of 52 credit units (in accordance with government regulations), with relevant and essential courses serving as the professional capital of graduates. These include Philosophy of Management Science, Quantitative and Qualitative Modeling, Research Methodology, studies of contemporary issues in management theory and practice, and empirical management models in marketing, finance, human capital, and operations. Al-Islam and Kemuhammadiyah serve as the religious foundation of the program. The dissertation constitutes the monumental scholarly work of PDIM-UMM students.

❖❖ Tuition Fees & Investment

The Semester Study Fee (BSS) includes the re-registration fee, tuition fee, study preparation, and orientation. The Semester Study Fee (BSS) may be paid in two installments each semester, namely the first installment (re-registration) and the second installment (prior to the Mid-Semester Examination).
